For selection of Consulting Services for "Comprehensive Master Plan for Integrated Irrigation Infrastructure development & Water Resource Management Plan in Merged Districts/Sub-Divisions with Feasibility Studies, Detailed Designs and Construction Supervision of high priority schemes"

1. The Government of Pakistan has requested from the International Development Agency (IDA - World Bank Group) in the amount of US\$ 200 million to fund the proposed **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Rural Investment and Institutional Support Project (P176780)**. Part of the proceeds of the Credit would be used for these consulting services.
2. The consulting services ("the Services") include: (a) Evaluate water resources and formulate a comprehensive master plan for water resources development in each of the eight merged districts and six sub-divisions (FRs); (b) Identify and prioritize schemes with a high level of urgency for implementation, with feasibility studies; (c) Prepare detailed designs and bidding documents for selected priority schemes (approximately 2-3), including the necessary social and environmental assessments and studies; (d) Oversee the construction of priority schemes through diligent supervision and management. The overall duration of the assignment will be 72 months. The assignment is expected to commence in August 2024.

4. Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Rural Investment and Institutional Support Project, Irrigation Department, Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa hereby invites EOI from eligible consulting firms ("the Consultants") for providing requisite services as per the TOR. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. Consultants are encouraged to provide only materials that would be specific to the proposed services, and to avoid submitting generic promotional material. The shortlisting criteria are:
 - (i) Have a minimum of ten (10) years of experience in detailed engineering design and construction supervision, with a focus on flood and irrigation infrastructure projects of similar complexity, as firm's core business, indicating the nature and scope of these assignments in areas of Feasibility, detailed design, construction supervision, procurement, contract administration, quality assurance, environment, management planning and implementation of resettlement action plan.
 - (ii) Demonstrate a proven track record by successfully completing at least three (03) similar assignments (*Flood & Irrigation infrastructure projects*) within the past ten (10) years. Provide details about these projects, highlighting involvement in design,

- construction supervision, procurement, contract administration, quality assurance, environmental compliance, management planning, and the implementation of resettlement action plans include information about payments made to the firm, person-months involved, and assignment durations.
- (iii) Provide detail about the logistical capacity of the firm, including the number of owned vehicles, survey equipment, IT equipment and software's (*preference will be given to the firm having latest equipment and technology*).
- (iv) Specify the number of technically qualified full-time employees within the firm who possess expertise in design and construction supervision. Key experts will not be evaluated, and CVs need not to be submitted at the shortlisting stage.
5. Consultants are requested to submit at least the following supporting documents in support of the above-mentioned criteria: (a) Registration documents of the firm(s); (b) JV agreement/letter of intent (*if applicable*); (c) Firm's brochure and (d) completion certificates/ copies of contract(s) etc., to substantiate the experience and projects requirements. And details with supporting documents to substantiate the logistic and management capacity.
6. The attention of the interested consultants is drawn to Section III - Governance, paragraphs 3.14 [Conflict of Interest], 3.16 and 3.17 [Consulting Services] of the World Bank's Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers November 2020, setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.
7. Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected. In case of an association (JV or Sub-consultancy), all members of such "association" should have real and well-defined inputs to the assignment and in such "association" it is preferable to limit the total number of firms to a maximum of 3.
8. A Consultant will be selected in accordance with Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method set out in the Procurement Regulations.
